Functionality	Integral Synchronization	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Required, but term not defined in the FMCSRs. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Interfaces with ECM, to capture engine power status, vehicle motion status, miles driven, engine hours. • Pre-2000 CMVs exempted.
	Location Tracking	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Required at each change of duty status. • Manual or automated. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Automates entry at change of duty status, at 60-min intervals while driving, engine on and engine-off instances, and at beginning and end of personal use and yard moves.
	Communications Methods	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Required. Paper-based or electronic. • eRODS format not defined in the FMCSRs. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Electronic transmission required. • eRODS output format defined.
	Tamper Resistance	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tamperproof. • Must identify failures or edited data in output. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tamperproof with increased indicator/malfunction monitoring. • Drivers can edit non-driving time with required annotations.
	Clock Time Drift	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Not required. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Time must be synchronized to UTC; absolute deviation must not exceed 10 minutes at any time.
Alerts/Display	Driver CDL (State and #) Display	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Not required. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must be captured and displayed in the header of the Daily log. Allowance in the Database will be done.
	VIN Number Display	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Not required. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must be captured and displayed in the header of the Daily log. • Allowance in the Database will be done.
	DOT Number Display	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Not required. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must be displayed on the header of the Daily log.
	eRODS Display	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Required, minimum defined information for the driver to see. • Format not defined by FMCSRs. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Extensive changes to Daily log Header and Detail log. • Must be able to present a graph grid of driver's daily duty status changes either on a display or on a printout.
	HOS Driver Alerts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Not required. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • HOS limits notification is not required. "Unassigned driving time/miles" warning must be provided upon login.
	Diagnostic Events and Malfunction Alerts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Required, but sensor failures are limited. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Extended functionality required, must be captured and displayed in the daily log detail and header. • Relay or display indicator required for driver.
Operations	Device "Default" Duty Status	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Not required. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Defaults to "On-duty Not Driving", when stopped for more than 5 minutes (triggers driver alert). • No other non-driver-initiated status change is allowed.
	"Unassigned Driving" Time Status	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Not required. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Driver must reconcile and approve or reject unassigned driving time at login. • If rejected, the Host Administrator must reconcile. • This will be used for in-house DOT audits.
	"Yard Move" Status	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Not required, but the market has driven vendors to provide. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Measures as ON-DUTY time in a private yard. • NO mileage limit or time. No Automatic limits allowed. • Manual select/deselect of Yard Move status. • Carrier may elect not to use Yard Move.
	"Personal Conveyance" Status	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Used in AOBRD but, only as defined by product. • Up to carrier or driver discretion. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • An event to record duration of time with GPS at no better than a 10 mile radius. • No defined limitation, warnings are allowed. • Carrier may elect to use or disallow.
	Driver Edits of Daily Logs	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Not allowed until 10/2015 through guidance. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Required, editing function must be provided to driver. • Any edits must have an annotation. • Driver cannot reduce or eliminate drive time. Other restrictions on edits apply.
	HOS Administrator Edits of Daily Logs	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Not defined. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Allowed - administrator edits pending until certified by driver. • Must be recorded in the ELD and reports. • Edits to logs beyond the 8 days required must be displayed to driver to accept or reject.
	Enforcement Transfer of Daily Logs	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Not required. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Driver will be engaged in the transfer to enforcement. • Supplier must make it as a single process for the driver with minimum effort.
	Driver SET UP with User and Password	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Not required. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Required - unique username and password along with driver status (EXEMPT and NON-EXEMPT DRIVERS). • EXEMPT would be for Road Test Mechanics, Relocation of Vehicles Short Distance, Short Haul drivers.
	Driver Certification of Daily Logs	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Not required. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Required driver certification every 24 hours of duty shift at minimum which includes acceptance of any log edits performed by HOS administrator.
	ELD Device Out of Service	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Not defined - must go to paper. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Device must be repaired in the vehicle within 8 days, paper logs are kept for the days out of service.
Other/Misc.		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • n/a 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must be registered with FMCSA. • Enforcement can access from outside of vehicle. • Portable devices must be mounted.
